Don't miss this public reading by the British poet Frances Leviston taking place here in Berlin! Her first collection, *Public Dream* (Picador, 2007), was one of the most acclaimed debuts of recent years. It was shortlisted for a number of literary prizes, such as the T S Eliot Prize. Her second collection, *Disinformation* (Picador, 2015), was shortlisted for the International Dylan Thomas Prize.

Frances Leviston was praised for combining "technical mastery with a lucidity that verges on the hypnotic" (*The Independent*). In 2006, she received an Eric Gregory Award from the Society of Authors. Her poems have appeared in *Poetry*, *London Review of Books*, the *Guardian*, *The Times*, the *TLS*, *Edinburgh Review*, and Granta/British Council *New Writing*.
